Effective immediately, all foreign suppliers that ship containers must adhere to the following:

- All seals used for containers or trailers must be ISO-17712 compliant and must meet or exceed the minimum ISO-17712 requirements for tensile strength, shear, bend and impact. No exceptions will be allowed.
- The supplier will appoint a Seal Custodian whose responsibility will be to document the
 receipt of seals to be used and record the date, time, type of seal, seal number
 sequence, quantity of seals and the name and signature of the company representative.
- 3. The Seal Custodian will conduct a monthly inventory to confirm all seals on hand. This documentation will be kept for a minimum of six (6) months.
- 4. All seals will be stored in a secured box, cabinet or safe, which is constructed of sturdy material affixed to a floor or building structure. The Seal Custodian and a designated Factory Manager will maintain the keys to the secured container.
- 5. The Seal Custodian will issue all seals in sequential order.
- 6. Any discrepancies regarding seal storage, inventory, usage or control will be immediately reported to the Factory Manager and investigated. The factory management will report these discrepancies to local law enforcement and U.S. Customs.
- 7. The seal number that is placed on the container, at the factory, prior to departure for export to the U.S.A. will be recorded on the truck Bill of Lading with the container number and the Purchase Order Number. All three of these numbers are recorded in the seal log and are maintained at the factory for a minimum of sic (6) months.
- 8. The seal number and the container number will be noted on all packing slips provided to us prior to arrival in the U.S.A.
- 9. Seals must be V-Verified; V-Viewed; T-Tugged; T-Twisted upon affixing to the container to ensure they are secure for transport.
